### **Rules and Regulations**

Must be at least 18 years of age to play.

- Tickets are \$5.00 each and may be purchased every week beginning Wednesday at 6pm.
- All ticket sales cease at 12:00 p.m. on the following Wednesday.
- Ticket sales locations:
  - Westown Variety, Cherryhill Mall, 301 Oxford Street West, London
  - Imperial Veterans Hall (Army-Navy), 38 Adelaide Street North, London
  - Keller Williams Lifestyles Realty, 509 Commissioners Road West, London
  - Asmara Caffee, 809 Dundas Street, London
  - Wine Worx, 971 Commissioners Road East, London
- One deck of 52 cards will be placed in sealed envelopes. Then randomly numbered from 1 to 52 and on display during the raffle.
- Only 500 Tickets available for purchase each week.
- **Purchaser MUST** - Complete ticket stub, including name, contact information, and one (1) envelope number (all information clearly printed). Enter a valid envelope number from the list of available numbers on display at the sales locations.
- The ticket purchaser will be responsible to ensure their ticket is filled out completely.
- Tickets are only valid for the weekly draw in which they were purchased.
- Ticket sales will be limited to four (4) tickets or less per person at the discretion of the CTA raffle committee.

### **Draw Time and Location**

- Wednesday, 5:30 p.m. at the Imperial Veterans Hall (Army-Navy), 38 Adelaide Street North, London.
- Only one (1) ticket will be drawn each week. See Draw Rules for Week 32 for special rules during that draw.
- The purchaser of the ticket drawn does not need to be in attendance to win.

November 9, 2017

- All draws will be video recorded live on Facebook, showing the name on the winning ticket and the envelope number selected on that ticket.

### **Draw Rules**

- Draw Prize, and Progressive Jackpot amounts, will be announced prior to each draw.
- At 5:30 p.m. one (1) ticket stub will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold that week. The winning ticket holder will receive the weekly prize amounting to 20% of that week's ticket sales. The envelope number shown on the ticket will be opened.
- If the ticket drawn does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number the CTA Raffle Committee will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number shown on the ticket. This person will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed.
- If unsuccessful in making contact the CTA Raffle Committee will select the lowest remaining envelope number.
- If the selected envelope does not contain the **Ace of Spades**, the card will be destroyed, and that envelope number will be removed from the following week's envelope selection. 30% of ticket sales from the draw each week will be rolled over to the **Progressive Jackpot**.
- If the selected envelope contains the **Ace of Spades**, the winner will also be awarded the Progressive Jackpot!!!
- This will conclude the series of draws for this raffle; a new raffle will begin at an advertised date.
- Winning ticket holder will be notified by phone and advised when they can claim their prize at the Imperial Veterans Hall (Army-Navy) located at 38 Adelaide Street North, London. A photo ID will be required to claim any prize.

All prizes awarded will be paid by cheque to the person named on the winning ticket.

### **Draw Rules - Week 32 Only**

- If after 31 weeks the **Ace of Spades** has not been revealed the Progressive Jackpot will be awarded on the 32nd week of the raffle. The draw will be held at the regular time at the Army Navy Club Hall. The winning ticket holder on week 32 will receive the weekly prize amounting to 20% of that week's ticket sales. The envelope number shown on the ticket will be opened to reveal the card inside.
- If the card is not the **Ace of Spades** another ticket will be drawn, this and all subsequent tickets drawn after the first ticket **will not win** the weekly prize but the envelope number shown on the ticket will be eligible for the Progressive Jackpot.
- If the ticket drawn does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number the CTA Raffle Committee will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number shown on the ticket. This person will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed.

- If unsuccessful in making contact the CTA Raffle Committee will select the lowest remaining envelope number.

The ticket holder that reveals the **Ace of Spades** will be declared the **JACKPOT WINNER!!!**
