#### The following business was conducted at the London Central Lions Board Meeting on Wednesday April 6, 2016

Motion (carried): to open a Trust Account to be used for the Trip of the Month Fundraiser, with three people with signing authority.

Motion of Recommendation (carried): that LCLC allow a budget of up to \$1000.00 for the celebration of our 50 plus year Lions, to be held at Trinity Lutheran Church on Saturday September 17 noon till 5 p.m.

Motion of Recommendation (carried): to adopt the Constitution and Bylaws as changed and presented. They have been emailed for perusal and study. Thanks to Joanne, Tricia, and Tony for all their hard work in making the changes.

London Spring Home and Garden Show: on April 15, 16 and 17 at the Agriplex Building. Lion Joanne reports that it is not mandatory for the booth to be manned, but any Lion who would like to be there to speak with the public can sign up. 
