Lions By The Numbers

The following facts present a picture of the evolution of Lions over the years "by the numbers". Please note that some of the numbers have likely changed since this research was done.

1917/6/7 — 38 year old Chicago USA business man Melvin Jones founded the "Association of Lions Clubs"

– the "Lions Association" became international with the formation of the Downtown Windsor Canada, 1920 Club

- in May, London Central Lions Club was chartered as the 4th oldest club in Canada 1921

1921-22 — Dr. Roy Routledge was London Central Lions Club's first president

 Lions membership stood at 60,000 in 1183 clubs world wide 1927
