

# Catch the Ace

## How Does it Work?

A standard deck of 52 playing cards and 52 envelopes begin the process. One card is inserted into each of the envelopes and the envelope is sealed. The sealed envelopes are mixed in a draw drum, removed one at a time and numbered 1 to 52. These envelopes are placed in a locked display case.

Ticket purchasers will need to choose & include an envelope number along with their name, phone number & address on their ticket stub.

Each of the sale locations will have a sheet showing the available numbers for the current weekly draw.

On Wednesday at 5:30 at the Imperial Veterans Hall (Army-Navy) one ticket will be drawn and the ticket holder will receive the weekly prize of 20% of the sales for that week (to a maximum of \$500). The envelope with the number that they chose will be opened to see if the **Ace of Spades** is inside. If it is not the Ace of Spades that card will be destroyed and the draw will progress to the next week.

If the winning ticket reveals the Ace of Spades the progressive jackpot will also be won which will be 30% of the accumulated ticket sales from each draw date.
