The following business was conducted at the London Central Lions Board Meeting on Wednesday Jan 31, 2018

Motion of Recommendation: to donate the proceeds from the Catch the Ace lottery to Childreach, a support centre for parents (carried).

Lion Jason will join Lion Tricia in investigating this possibility. We would need to know what the expenses are going to be, and we would likely have to secure funds again.

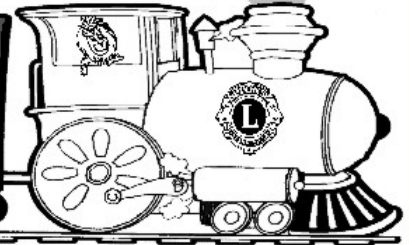

February Board of Directors Meeting (continued):

Lion Lee-Anne noted that we need to decide what to do with the \$15,530.33 that was just freed up and deposited into our admin account. After some discussion:

Motion of Recommendation: to use up the \$15,530.33 as follows: \$5000.00 to Welfare, \$5000.00 to a "Rainy Day" account, \$5000.00 to Merrymount Children's Center, and the remainder to stay in Admin (carried).

Zone Project – Lion Tricia Lystar - The Zone Project this year is Martin's House for the Blind and Deaf. They need work done in their kitchen.

Motion of Recommendation: to donate \$500.00 to Martin's House for the Blind and Deaf (carried).

Motion of Recommendation: that the club hold a Rainbarrel fundraiser on Saturday May 26 (only need 2-3 people) - carried.

Dog Walk BBQ – Lion Tricia Lystar

Motion of Recommendation: to let the Dog Walk Committee man our first BBQ in May as before (carried).
